Student and Parent Contract

JWCPA's Summer Camp seeks to teach students the art of musical theater: singing, acting, movement, character development and technical skills. We believe every student has a gift or talent, perhaps one or several, that we hope to help develop individually and/or in group classes for presentation of a live production to an audience at the end of the camp on June 28th and June 29 at Westbrook High School Theater. We have listed below your personal responsibilities as a member of the JWCPA Summer Camp and production and those of parents or guardians. We ask for your cooperation and assistance in creating a positive, fun-filled, and safe environment for our participants. We have a "zero tolerance" policy towards inappropriate behavior such as offensive language, rude or inappropriate conversations, bullying, abusing or damaging property, smoking, illegal drug use and/or any physical contact that is considered harmful or improper for other campers.

Please review the following important requirements and procedures with your child and acknowledge your acceptance by your student's signature and by the parent's or guardian's signature below.

- Respect your teachers, classmates, property, and yourself always by promptly arriving for class
 or rehearsal, participating, listening to instructions and class discussions, speaking appropriately
 without disrupting the class or rehearsal.
- Observe camp instructions and guidelines, complete assignments timely, pay attention to all announcements given, memorize music and lines as assigned.

- Attend camp each day unless advance notice is provided by a parent/guardian or an emergency occurs to Camp administrator by phone (832) 888-0947 text or email him as soon as possible at jwcpa.jw@gmail.com.
- Accept the role assigned to you as every part/student is vital to the success of the show. All
 camp participants will have a "on-stage" or technical part in the musical play. Speaking roles,
 singing solos, ensembles and dance groups will be determined at the discretion of camp
 instructors and administrators prior to or by the first or second week of camp.
- Scripts: Students should bring their SCRIPT (BOOK) to class every day (if memorized or not) and a sharpened PENCIL in a binder with a pencil and highlighter in a 3 whole pencil holder. Be sure to wright their name on it with permanent marker. As students are given lines, solo or chorus work, please ask the camp instructors to MARK and INITIAL it in your child's script for you to help them rehearse and memorize at home (camp requirement of parents).
- Be prepared and focused for each rehearsal. Arrive at least 10 minutes (not more than 20 minutes) prior to camp start time to socialize, warm up and stretch to get ready to learn.
 Reminder: Bring your script and pencil daily.
- Prepare or memorize lines, songs, movement and blocking on time as assigned.
- Parental involvement required. See areas to volunteer below.
- Behavior and dress should be appropriate for school.
- Respect the building(s) where camp is held. All trash should be put in recycle or trash cans.
- Eating during camp sessions or rehearsal is not allowed. Bottled water IS permitted, but not on staged area(s).
- Please do not leave the building before being dismissed by director or instructors unless approved by a JWCPA staff member. **Parents must sign student in and out each day.**
- Cell phones are not permitted during class or rehearsals. They should be silenced and put away with your belongings during camp. ABSOLUTELY NO CELL PHONE USE IS PERMITTED DURING CAMP OR PERFORMANCES. If an emergency arises, parents can contact staff at 832-888-0947.
- Attend required tech. sessions to help with set construction, set painting, props, costumes, etc.
- Attend set strike (take down of set) following the performance unless excused by directors.
- Care for and/or provide costume(s) and costume pieces as requested. \$10 cleaning fee requested.
- Assist with simple organization or clean-up after each session daily.

• Refund Policy: A 100% refund will be available until June 3. After this time, 80% will be given until June 7. No refunds will be given after June 7th. No refunds will be given as a result of a child not receiving the part they feel they should have in the production. Students may present their case, if they feel a role is suited for them, but administrators and instructors have final responsibility to assign roles for the production. Every consideration will be given in each assignment to the student's experience and ability.

Students and parents should support the JWCPA Summer Camp commitment to excellence, and my student agrees to do his/her best in session participation, performance(s) and abide by all guidelines set forth by the JWCPA staff. I further understand that if my student does not follow these guidelines, he/she will be asked to leave the camp at the discretion of the camp administration without a refund.

Please Note: Our Production Contract requires that we notify you of the following: So that there is no disruption of the production, all video recording of the production is restricted to an authorized professional. Video copies will be available for purchase and may be used for personal, at-home, non-commercial use only. The sale or distribution of such recording by purchaser is strictly prohibited under federal copyright law. In addition, in no case may any video recording of the production in whole or in part be reproduced and/or disseminated in any way, including broadcasting, televising, sale or electronic transmission and/or posting on the Internet. This also includes Facebook, TikTok, Tweeter or other social media.
